About the Charity

The St Martin-in-the-Fields Charity helps people who are experiencing or at risk of becoming homeless. We are best known for our annual BBC Radio 4 Christmas Appeal with St Martin-in-the-Fields. The money we raise directly supports people through The Connection at St Martin-in-the-Fields and across the UK through the Vicar's Relief Fund (VRF) and the Frontline Network.



About the VRF

The Vicar's Relief Fund helps homeless and vulnerably-housed people through small, quick grants that prevent eviction or help people get accommodation.

We award grants of up to £350, and we usually process grant requests in 1-3 days. We give grants to people across the UK through frontline workers.




